

Tilting Tardis Fingerless Mitts



I made these fingerless mitts to go with the Tilting Tardis Cowl by Marilyn Phillippi. The lace pattern is a little different, I added little purled panels, but it has the same number of stitches as the original pattern.

Gauge: 6 stitches per inch in knit 2, purl 2 rib on larger needle.

Finished size: Wrist Circumference = 6.5 inches, Palm (at widest point) circumference = 8.5 inches, Length of hand (from edge of rib) = 4.5 inches

Needles: Size 2 needles and double pointed size 1 needles.

Yarn: 100 grams sport weight. I used two balls of Knit Picks' Telemark in Skyline.

Other Supplies: Yarn needle, four buttons, sewing needle, thread, and about 8 inches of ribbon or fabric for the button tabs.

Note: I made my button tabs out of ribbon but you could use fabric or even knit them. However, knitted tabs may be uncomfortable because of the added bulk.

Lace pattern:

Multiple of 13 stitches + 2

BC = Slip 2 stitches to dpn , hold to back, knit 2, knit 2 off dpn.

FC = Slip 2 stitches to dpn , hold to front, knit 2, knit 2 off dpn.

Lace pattern in worked by repeating rows 2 through 17

Row 1(setup row): k5, p1, k5, p2

Row 2: k1 (yo, k2tog) twice, p1, k5, p2

Row 3: k5, p2, k4, p2

Row 4: k1, (yo, k2tog) twice, p2, k4, p2

Row 5: k5, p2, k4, p2

Row 6: k1, (p1,k1) twice, p2, BC, p2

Row 7: k5, p2, k4, p2

Row 8: k1, (p1,k1) twice, p2, k4, p2

Row 9: k5, p1, k5, p2

Row 10: k5, p1, (ssk, yo) twice, k1, p2

Row 11: k4, p2, k5, p2

Row 12: k4, p2, (ssk, yo) twice, k1, p2

Row 13: k4, p2, k5, p2

Row 14: FC, p2, (k1, p1) twice, k1, p2

Row 15: k4, p2, k5, p2

Row 16: k4, p2, (k1, p1) twice, k1, p2

Row 17: k4, p2, k5, p2

Right Mitt:

On size 2's, cast on 40 stitches.

Row 1: k2, p2 to end

Row 2: k2, p2 to end

Row 3: k2, p2, k2tog, yo, p2, *k2, p2 repeat from * to end

Row 4: k2, p2 to end

work k2, p2 rib for 6 more rows (7 rows of rib from button hole row)

Row 11: k2, p2, k2tog, yo, p2, *k2, p2 repeat from * to end

Row 12: k2, p2 to end

Work 2 more rows of rib.

Switch to size 1 double pointed needles and work in round.

Row 15 (1st row on size 1s): k2, p2 to end

Row 16: k2, p2 to end

Row 17: k4, pm, k13, pm, k to end

Row 18: p4, slip marker, k5, p1, k5, p2, slip marker, p2, k to end. (Lace row 1 worked between markers)

Rows 19-24: p4, slip marker, work lace pattern, slip marker, p2, k to end

Thumb Gusset:

Work increases for thumb while continuing to work lace pattern over 13 sts between markers.

Row 25: p4, slip marker, work lace(you should be on row 8), slip marker, p2, k6, inc 1, k to end. (41 stitches total)

Row 26: p4, slip marker, work lace, slip marker, p2, k to end.

Row 27: p4, slip marker, work lace, slip marker, p2, k6, inc 1, k to end. (42 stitches total)
Row 28: p4, slip marker, work lace, slip marker, p2, k to end.
Row 29: p4, slip marker, work lace, slip marker, p2, k6, inc 1, k2, inc 1, k to end. (44 stitches total)
Row 30: p4, slip marker, work lace, slip marker, p2, k to end.
Row 31: p4, slip marker, work lace, slip marker, p2, k6, inc 1, k4, inc 1, k to end. (46 stitches total)
Row 32: p4, slip marker, work lace, slip marker, p2, k to end.
Row 33: p4, slip marker, work lace, slip marker, p2, k6, inc 1, k6, inc 1, k to end. (48 stitches total)
Row 34: p4, slip marker, work lace (lace row 17), slip marker, p2, k5, k10 and place on holder, k to end(38 stitches total and 10 thumb stitches)
Row 35: p4, slip marker, work lace row 2, slip marker, p2, k to end.
Continue working on mitt until finished with second lace repeat(15 more rows).
Cast off loosely.

Thumb:

Row 1: knit 10 off of holder, pick up 5 stitches over hand.
Knit 5 rows and cast off loosely.

Left Mitt:

On size 2's, cast on 40 stitches.

Row 1: p2, k2 to end

Row 2: p2, k2 to end

Row 3: p2, k2 to last 6 sts, yo, k2tog, p2, k2

Row 4: p2, k2 to end

work p2, k2 rib for 6 more rows (7 rows of rib from button hole row)

Row 11: p2, k2 to last 6 sts, yo, k2tog, p2, k2

Row 12: p2, k2 to end

Work 2 more rows of rib.

Switch to size 1 double pointed needles and work in round.

Row 15 (1st row on size 1s): p2, k2 to end

Row 16: p2, k2 to end

Row 17: k23, pm, k13, pm, k4

Row 18: k21, p4, slip marker, k5, p1, k5, p2, slip marker, p2. (Lace row 1 worked between markers)

Rows 19-24: k21, p4, slip marker, work lace pattern, slip marker, p2.

Thumb Gusset:

Work increases for thumb while continuing to work lace pattern over 13 sts between markers.

Row 25: k15, inc 1, k6, p4, slip marker, work lace(you should be on row 8), slip marker, p2. (41 stitches total)

Row 26: k22, p4, slip marker, work lace pattern, slip marker, p2.

Row 27: k16, inc 1, k6, p4, slip marker, work lace, slip marker, p2. (42 stitches total)

Row 28: k23, p4, slip marker, work lace pattern, slip marker, p2.
Row 29: k15, inc 1, k2, inc 1, k6, p4, slip marker, work lace, slip marker, p2. (44 stitches total)
Row 30: k25, p4, slip marker, work lace pattern, slip marker, p2.
Row 31: k15, inc 1, k4, inc 1, k6, p4, slip marker, work lace, slip marker, p2. (46 stitches total)
Row 32: k27, p4, slip marker, work lace pattern, slip marker, p2.
Row 33: k15, inc 1, k6, inc 1, k6, p4, slip marker, work lace, slip marker, p2. (48 stitches total)
Row 34: k14, k10 and place on holder, k5, p4, slip marker, work lace (lace row 17), slip marker, p2. (38 stitches total and 10 thumb stitches)
Row 35: k19, p4, slip marker, work lace row 2, slip marker, p2.
Continue working on mitt until finished with second lace repeat(15 more rows).
Cast off loosely.

Thumb:

Row 1: knit 10 off of holder, pick up 5 stitches over hand.
Knit 5 rows and cast off loosely.

Finishing:

Cut ribbon into four pieces for button tabs. Mine are about 2 inches long but make sure you try your gloves on first and decide how long you want them. Sew tabs onto inside of cuff making sure they line up with the button holes opposite. Sew on buttons. Weave in ends.
